Connecting Home Experiences with Literacy Learning

 Using Digital Cameras to Highlight Multilingual Family Experiences

As a Result of the Mini Innovation Grant Funding:

- Seven digital cameras were purchased
- 27 Active Multilingual Learners at HWES were invited to participate in the project



Steps Taken:

After families elected to participate with the project, students:

- Learned to use digital cameras at school
- 2. Took photographs at home
- 3. Selected their favorite photographs/subject matter

- 4. Returned the cameras for photograph printing
- 5. Took printed photographs home to share with families
- 6. Returned photographs with captions written in home languages to school

Note Sent Home to Families in Their Requested Language

Students were asked to photograph:

My favorite place

An activity that I enjoy

A holiday that is special to me

A tradition that I love

Something that I am proud of

Dear Family of a Multilingual Student.

Happy New Year! Next week, selected students will bring home a digital camera to use at home for three days. The students will bring the camera home to take pictures that remind them of one or more of the following themes:

My favorite place
An activity that I enjoy
A holiday that is special to me
A tradition that I love
Something that I am proud of
Other

After the third day, students will return the camera to school, and will choose 3-5 of their favorite pictures to print. Of the printed photos, students will select one photo to write about.

We will send this favorite photo home with a request that family members help children write about their picture in the home language that they choose (Arabic, Bengali, Chinese, English, French, Hebrew, Japanese, Pashto, Portuguese, Spanish, Tagalog, Ukrainan, Urdu, etc.).



We will collect these pictures and responses at the school, and compile them into a book to share with our school community. Each family that participates will receive their own copy of the book to keep.




