
As we embark on this journey together, let us embrace the spirit of collaboration, resilience, and positivity. Together, we can make this school year a truly enriching and memorable experience for our students.



If you arrive on campus during school hours to pick up or drop off your student(s), you must park in the parking lot and walk into the main office. Please do not park in the **red** fire lane along the front of the school as local law enforcement and emergency services have directed. Students will not be allowed to exit the building unless an adult has come into the building to sign them out. Proper ID will be required when signing out a student. Thank you.

- If your child will need to take medication during school hours, please complete a medication permission form. These can be found on the school website, or can be sent home with your child. All prescription medications require a physician's signature.
- All health plans need to be updated at the start of each year. (asthma, seizure, allergy, diabetes, etc..)
- Please be sure to notify the front office of any changes in your contact information.

After School Dismissal Procedures:

We hope to share some essential details about our dismissal time and traffic patterns each afternoon at Waddell to help everyone have a safe and smooth dismissal process.

- → All students in grades K-5 dismiss at 2:45 PM. At this time, students will begin exiting the school building to report to their assigned locations outside.
- → Students riding the shuttle bus and all walkers will be dismissed first. Walkers and bike riders will be dismissed to the ends of the school building near the playground or gym crosswalk. Adults should wait in this area for their child. Feel free to ask a teacher on duty to call for your child. We will have faculty members stationed at both corners to call for your child in case they forget. The sidewalk in front of the school is closed to parents and visitors during arrival and dismissal.
- → Car riders in K-5 will be dismissed next. As you enter the parking lot, please enter the **left side lane** in the upper parking lot. The center crosswalk is closed during arrival and dismissal times. Once the left side lane is full, please start the right side lane. The lanes will be dismissed by alternating a car from each lane. To help keep our parking lot open, please do not begin a second line until the first line is full. Also, we ask that you not arrive on campus for dismissal before 2:30 PM.
- → The lower "loading" lane is a single lane of traffic. Please do not pull into the left-hand lane around traffic unless directed to do so by school staff. When the car lane is moving, please pull forward in line and follow the direction of school staff on duty.
- → All car riders must be loaded through the car line. Please make sure your student's name is visible (printed in dark ink) on the colored car tag provided for you, located in your passenger side front window so we can quickly identify your car for pick up.
- → We ask that any changes for afternoon student dismissal plans be communicated to the main office before 2:00 PM.
- → No adults/visitors/pets are allowed in front of the school during arrival or dismissal time. This allows our teachers and staff to keep a close eye on all students and listen for radio calls.
- → The center crosswalk through the parking lot is closed during arrival and dismissal times.
- → While students are allowed to stay after school on the playground, we prefer that students walk home unless they are supervised by an adult. The playground is not supervised afterschool by the Waddell staff.
