As you know, this year we have introduced the VALLS test statewide to better assess our students' reading skills in grades K-3. I am pleased to report that we have completed our fall testing, and the results are promising: only 20% of our students in grades K-3 are in need of additional reading support. This is a positive reflection of our students' progress and the hard work of our dedicated teachers.

Our educators have been diligently implementing the use of High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM) as part of our new literacy components. This rigorous approach is designed to engage our students more deeply and support their growth as confident readers.

We remain committed to ensuring that every child receives the support they need to thrive. Thank you for your continued partnership as we strive to provide the best possible education for our students. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out.

Recently, our community has seen a rise in cases of children with respiratory illnesses, with some children ending up with "walking pneumonia." According to the CDC, these illnesses may be caused by *Mycoplasma pneumoniae*. *M. pneumoniae* is a common reason for respiratory illness. Infections are generally mild and present as a chest cold with fever, cough, and sore throat. Sometimes, it can cause a less severe form of pneumonia known as "walking pneumonia."
